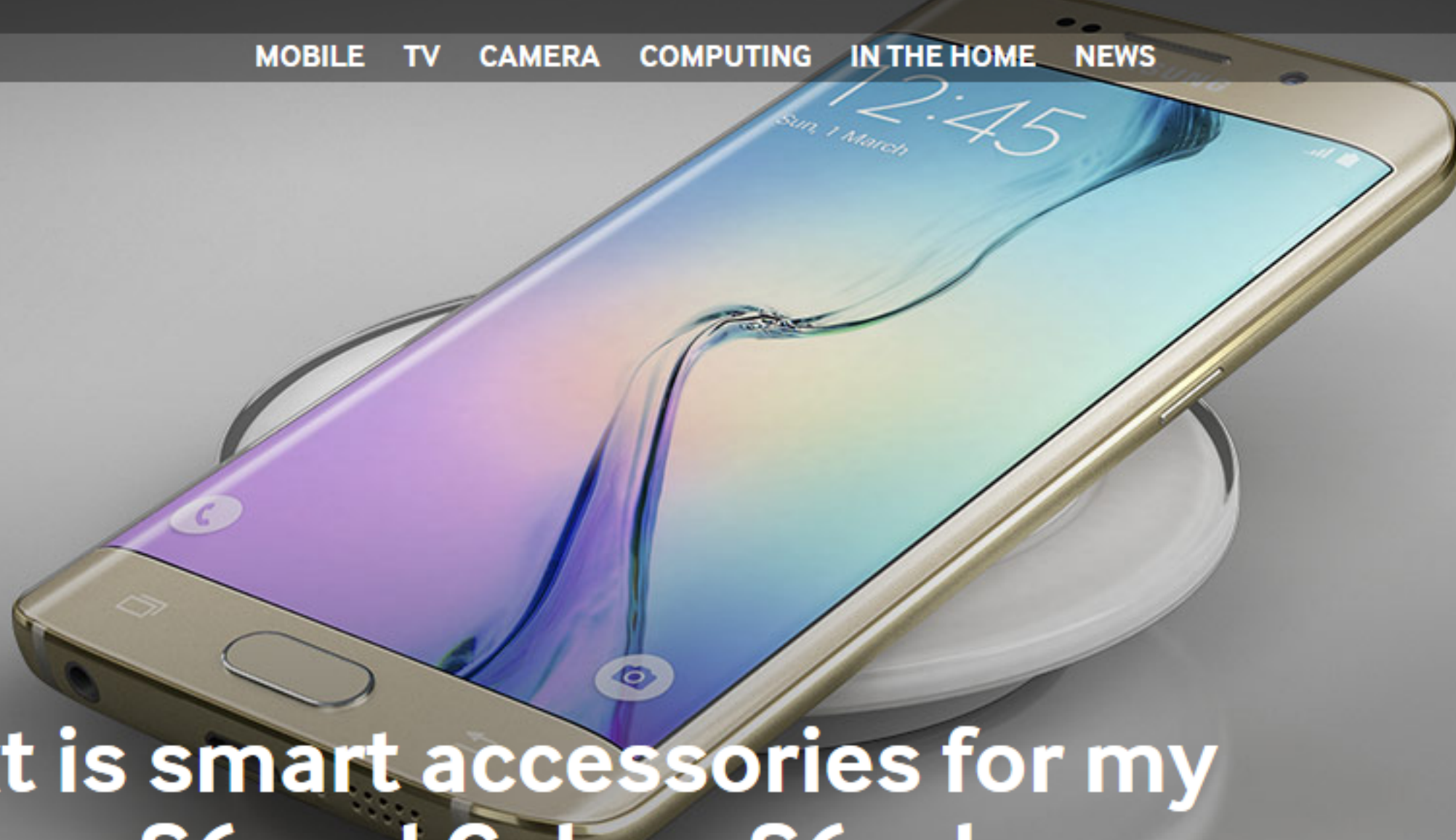

Next is effortless

One of the first new Galaxy S6 smartphones I saw at the Mobile World Conference was sitting on a pad. The Samsung man next to me must have noticed my curious look. "The Galaxy S6 is charging," he said. Now this was odd, as the phone wasn't plugged into anything. I examined it more closely. "The pad is a Samsung **Wireless Charger**," he explained. A good idea, I thought. Rather than having to fumble around to connect my phone to a power point, now I can just place the Galaxy S6 on the pad, and it charges. A simple, time-saving solution.

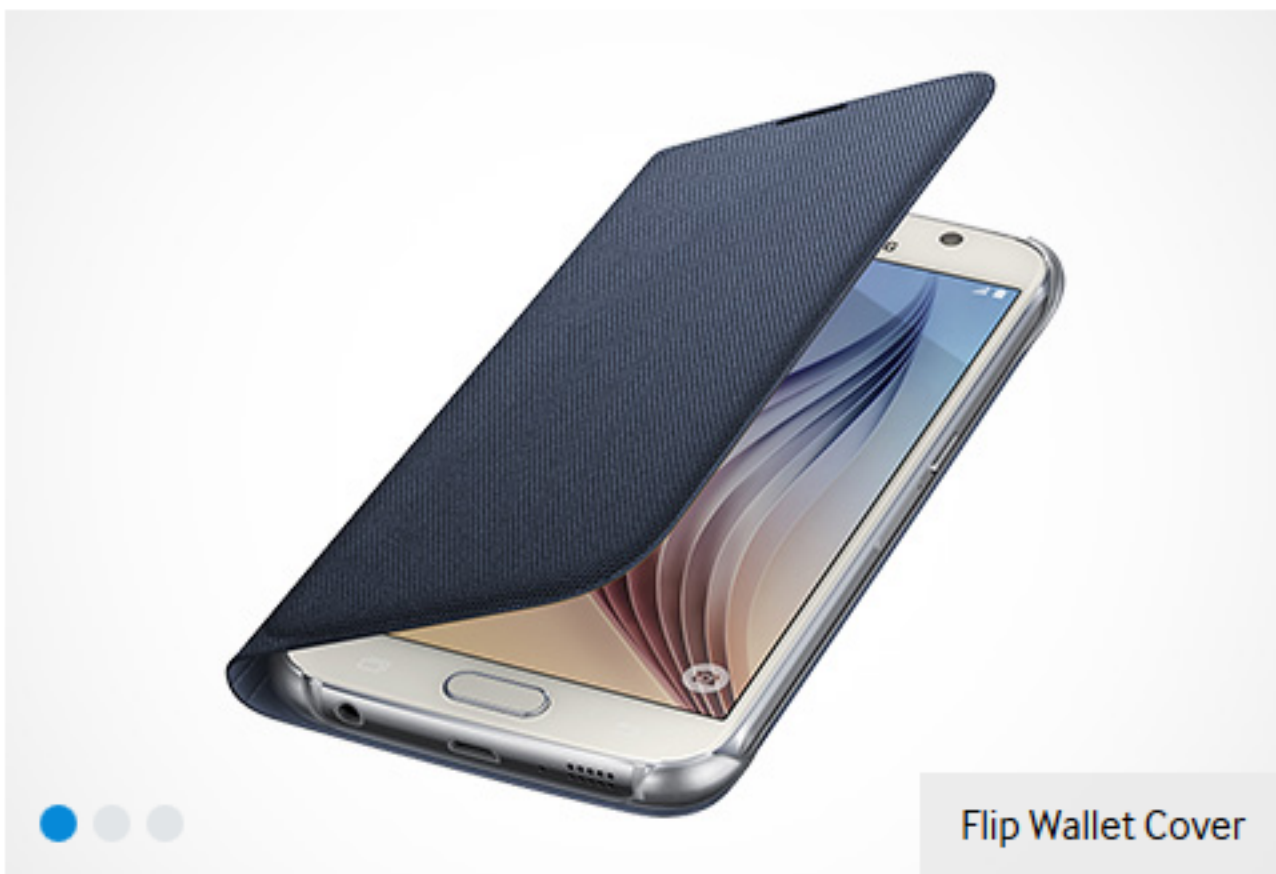
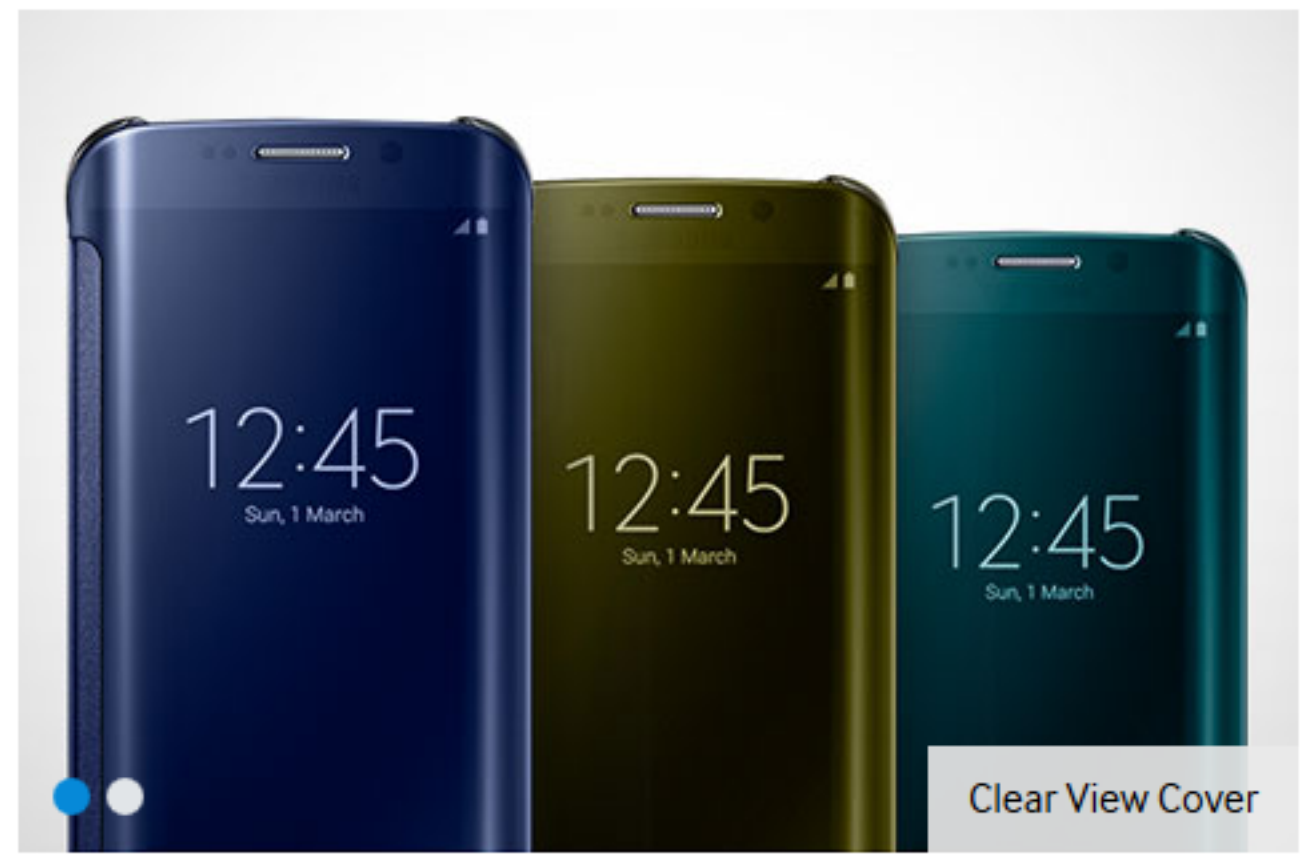

Next is clear

I thought phone covers just protected your handset until I saw Samsung's brilliant **Clear View** and **S View** covers. On top of safeguarding your Galaxy S6, they also let you see the screen display. Very handy when you're standing on a packed train with only one hand free. With Clear View you can check the time and get message alerts and answer calls - all without needing to open the cover. The S View has a window to let you see your clock as well as text and call notifications.

Both covers come in a range of stylish colours. I like how they fit snugly around the Galaxy S6, and give a better, more comfortable grip without making the phone bulkier.



There are three more great ways to protect your Galaxy S6 - with a faux-leather **Flip Wallet** Cover, a Protective Cover or a **Clear** Cover. The former, available in six colours, is what I'd want my handset to wear to important meetings. It has a warm, soft feel and, while safeguarding the front and back of your phone, gives you a good grip. Inside, there's a slot for your business cards.

If you just want to protect your Galaxy S6 from shocks, but keep it visible and easy to get at, you may prefer the Protective Case. Covering only the back, it's made of a leather-like material, offering a soft grip. It comes in five colours. I'm keen on the Protective Case as it shows off the Galaxy S6's beautiful design.

Next is smarter audio

If, like me, you find headphone cables annoying, here's some good news. There's a wireless headphone system that'll soon be available for the new **Galaxy S6** and **Galaxy S6 edge**. It's the best I've seen.

I tried a pair of the new headphones at the Mobile World Conference. No sooner had I put them on than the hubbub of the exhibition hall stopped, thanks to their Active Noise Cancelling. They connected instantly to the Galaxy S6, and my head was filled with the rich, balanced sound of my favourite band. The quality was unbelievably good. The headphones fitted like a dream, and they didn't look bad in the mirror either. With the smart Touch Control Panel I felt in complete control of the sound. And when the Samsung lady called me on the Galaxy S6 while I was listening to the music, there was no echo.
